



COVID-19 Prevention at Kitzbühel Triathlon Events

June 17 – 20, 2021

- + ETU European Super Sprint Triathlon Championships for Juniors, U23 and Elite Athletes
- + Austrian Super Sprint Championships for Ages 10 – 18 Years

To reduce the risk of exposure to and the spread of SARS-CoV-2 virus for members of the press before, during and after the Kitzbühel Triathlon Championships, following mitigation and safety measures will be implemented:

1. Proof of Low Risk Status

Everybody who is allowed by accreditation to access the Restricted Area during the event, must submit a negative Covid-19 test, a certificate of recovery and/or proof of vaccination. Tested, recovered and vaccinated persons are treated equally, with the validity period varying depending on the type of evidence.

1.1. Covid Tests

Test results must come from an authorized testing center. Following types are accepted:

- A negative SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Self-Test, no older than 24 hours.
- A negative SARS-CoV-2 Antigen Test, no older than 48 hours.
- A negative PCR test for SARS-CoV-2, no older than 72 hours.

Negative test results must be available in hard copy or as PDF on your mobile device. Test results via text message are not accepted.

1.2 Recovery from SARS-CoV-2

Proof of recovery:

- Documentation from a licensed health care provider of having recovered from SARS-CoV-2 (valid for 6 months);
- Proof of quarantine after a positive SARS-CoV-2 test result within the past 6 months;
- Test showing Covid antibodies (valid for 3 months);

1.3 Covid Vaccination

You are considered vaccinated:

- after 22 but no more than 90 days have passed since your first dose;
- after your second dose, if no more than 9 months have passed since your first dose;
- after 22 days but no more than 9 months have passed since your shot with a single-dose vaccine;
- on the day of your Covid-19 vaccination provided that you had a positive PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 and/or proof of antibodies 21 days prior to your Covid-19 vaccine and the date of your Covid-19 vaccination was no more than 9 months ago.
